LET'S GO GUAM: Central villages energized

Nearly 500 people from 7 villages across central Guam gathered Sunday evening to show their trust in Josh Tenorio and Tina Muña-Barnes and the gubernatorial team's vision for a more affordable and prosperous Guam.

The Tenorio Muña-Barnes campaign continues its regularly-scheduled meet and greet events, which gives supporters and undecided voters the chance to hear from Democratic and Attorney General candidates ahead of this year's elections. Sunday's event, held in Barrigada, also served residents from Tamuning, Mongmong-Toto-Maite, Hagåtña, and Agana Heights.

"One of the biggest things we are hard at work at is giving families an affordable place to live. Tina has authored legislation to make low-income housing tax credits happen. That's led to thousands of homes and apartments being built. She championed the program that gives grants to first-time homeowners. We're going to increase investments into these opportunities. It's imperative to give these kinds of tools to our people — to keep them here at home," Tenorio said. "We will help our young families build their future, because Democrats are builders. We built schools. We built gyms. We built homes. And we will build wealth across our island. When we reinvest in the community, we make lasting change for the better."

"Josh is the only person running for Governor I trust to lead this island into the future. The opportunities and challenges on the horizon mean we need to elect someone who has been tested and who has a record of delivering results. Someone who can negotiate with Washington on behalf of our grassroots. That man is Josh Tenorio," Muña-Barnes said.

Barrigada Mayor June Blas, one of 14 Mayors who endorse the Tenorio Muña-Barnes team, welcomed the crowd by pointing out the improvements to roadways and recreational facilities in her village.

"The Vice Mayor and I have lots of dreams. Thanks to the Lt. Governor and this administration, so many of our dreams came true. They filled the potholes. They paved the streets. They built a ponding basin. They built a new gym. They connected us with grants to repair our facilities. They made a World War II memorial happen. I could go on and on," she said. "We have so many kids using the basketball court. We want more kids on that court and out of the Superior Court. That's the good that happens when we come together as one. We've got your back. Let's go, Barrigada! Let's go, Guam!"
