The island's northernmost village came out strong in its support for Josh Tenorio and Tina Muña-Barnes Thursday, at the Democratic gubernatorial ticket's latest village meet and greet.

Can you imagine what good will happen when we build a first-rate school for this first-rate community?"

"We will help Guam do better, be better. There is so much passion surrounding us. And I'm most humbled that 14 out of our 19 Mayors are supporting Josh and me. That's a testament to their belief this team will help our families where it matters most," Muña-Barnes said. "Our top priority is you. To give you a life that is meaningful, is fruitful We will never close our doors on our people."

Mayor Frances Lizama, rallied the crowd around the team with a ringing endorsement, urging voters to support Josh and Tina because of their record of service and results.

"Yigo is ready. Tonight, we are energized. Tonight, we stand united. And tonight, we rise together for the future of our island. We are here because we believe in their leadership, because we believe in their service," she said. "Having known Josh for over 10 years, I've seen his leadership, his dedication, and his heart. He has compassion and the vision to move Guam forward. Josh is ready to lead and he is ready to serve our island. I've known Tina for many years. She's a fighter, a leader, and our champion.
