LET'S GO GUAM: Chalan Pago-Ordot pushes Josh & Tina closer to victory

Riding the momentum from a strong showing at the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce Gubernatorial Forum, Josh Tenorio and Tina Muña-Barnes continue to spread their vision to transform Guam into a more affordable and prosperous place to raise a family.

"We will make Guam more affordable by investing in our people. Tina and I will give you more tools to raise wages. We will open a vocational high school to connect students with good jobs before they even graduate," Tenorio said. "In a few weeks, we will be engaging with federal agencies to secure investments in our infrastructure. For underground power lines. For even better roads. For a new hospital. For projects that help all of Guam, but also helps the military do its job to protect the homeland here. Some candidates don't want to build bridges with our partners. They would rather put walls up, but that's not how Tina and I were raised. The island we love doesn't sacrifice people over egos."

The candidates received a warm welcome from nearly 400 people during their latest meet and greet event, held in Chalan Pago-Ordot — the home district for the ticket's candidate for Lieutenant Governor.

"We just had our first forum last week. And I gotta tell you. When Josh is side by side with our opponents — nobody comes close to his knowledge, his vision, and his ability. Some people had to be given handpicked questions. And Josh defended the Chamoru right to self determination while the rest of the field played coy. He will fight for you when others cut and run," Muña-Barnes said.

Mayor Wayne Santos joined two predecessors: Jesse Gogue and Roseanna San Miguel in endorsing the team, touting Tenorio's investments into community programs and facilities as their reasons for backing the Democratic ticket. And for Chalan Pago resident Shirley Brennan Harvey-Samuel, her support for Tenorio and Muña-Barnes is rooted in her deep respect for their leadership.

"I've lived in Maimai for more than 60 years. Sometime in the early 90s our little village road was paved and we honestly thought we had died and gone to heaven. But since then our road once again became pot-holed and rutted. We tried meetings with past administrations who told us to be patient, to wait our turn. Along comes Lt. Governor Josh Tenorio, and he made this overdue project happen," she said. "Josh and Tina are clearly the most intelligent, obviously the most articulate, and by far the most capable team running. I look forward to them taking the reins in January."
