LET'S GO GUAM: Humåtak solidly behind Tenorio Muña-Barnes

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Josh Tenorio and Tina Muña-Barnes resumed their village meet and greets in Humåtak Thursday evening, where about 150 supporters and undecided voters welcomed the gubernatorial team. The candidates, riding a wave of momentum from a highly successful fundraiser the night before, continued to spread their message of Guamanian unity and vision of a prosperous future for our families.

In the wake of Typhoon Sinlaku, Lt. Governor Tenorio paid special attention to southern villages like Humåtak to verify how effective mitigation efforts were in place for flood-prone areas, and to ensure post-storm work focused on the neighborhoods that need it most.

“When you build things like new gyms, new parks, better community spaces — families will come back to where they grew up. Some people will say, ‘Why focus on Humåtak when there’s so many more people in Dededo?’ Because there’s value here. This is one of the gems of the entire Pacific, this village. One of the oldest communities in the region. And every village deserves this kind of attention, this kind of investment. It’s simple: investing in our people means investing in our future.”

“It’s not enough to tell people who you’re fighting. Josh and I will focus on what we’re fighting for. And that, my friends, is how Guam moves forward. With positivity. With action. With vision; not division,” Muña-Barnes said. “Every time Josh was given a task, it didn’t matter what it was. He delivered — in every branch of government, in the private sector, in Washington, D.C. That’s why he’s the right choice for our people.”

Republican Mayor Johnny “Båda” Quinata shared that despite being from another party, he is endorsing Josh and Tina because of the unwavering support the Lt. Governor has shown during his tenure. These efforts include the construction of an open-air gymnasium, the renovation of recreational facilities, and the rehabilitation of abandoned homes.

“My family has always been Republican, but I know who’s been helping me, and that’s who I’m gonna support,” he said. “It’s not about the party now. It’s about who’s helping you. The Lt. Governor has been helping this village. And he’s never stopped. I don’t know about the others, but this guy is very good. I would never turn my back on him. I love you sir, and I’m never gonna change.”
