Following successful meet and greet events in Hågat and Yona, Josh Tenorio and Tina Muña-Barnes continued their months-long engagement with voters in Talo'fo'fo' Sunday evening — a district-wide event that also included hundreds of families living in Humåtak, Inalåhan, and Malesso'.
